Suggested Answers for Common Questions

C. “Why does evil exist? If God is so good and powerful, why can't He stop evil?”

Gen 3 – show them when evil came into the world ...and why.

Rom 5:12 - ... just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned--

Rom 3:10 - as it is written, "THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE;

Jer 17:9 - The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it?

Rom 3:23 - for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

C. “Why does evil exist? If God is so good and powerful, why can't He stop evil?”

Psa 5:4–5 - **4** For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; No evil dwells with You. **5** The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes; You hate all who do iniquity.

Rom 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.



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Suggested Answers for Common Questions

D. “In the end, everyone will be saved. It really doesn’t matter what you believe, as long as you have faith.”

Isa 44:6, 8 - 6 Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the first and I am the last, And there is no God besides Me...**8**...Is there any God besides Me, Or is there any other Rock? I know of none.'

S Lewis Johnson: As in arithmetic, there's only one right answer to a sum, and all others are wrong.



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

D. “In the end, everyone will be saved. It really doesn’t matter what you believe, as long as you have faith.”

John 14:6 - Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Gal 2:16 - 16 nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

Titus 3:5 - He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

D. “In the end, everyone will be saved. It really doesn’t matter what you believe, as long as you have faith.”

Acts 4:12 - And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

Matt 7:13–14 - **13** "Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. **14** "For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

E. “God will accept me because I’m a good person. He knows my heart, and I have done a lot of good things.”

James 2:10 - For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all.

Matt 5: 21-30, 45

v. 45 – “Therefore, you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Isa 64:6 - For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; And all of us wither like a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

Gen 6:5 - Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

Jer 17:9–10 - 9 "The heart is more deceitful than all else
And is desperately sick; Who can understand it? **10** "I,
the LORD, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give
to each man according to his ways...



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

Eph 2:8–9 – **8** For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; **9** not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Titus 3:5 – He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit...



Suggested Answers for Common Questions

F. “Isn’t the Bible full of errors?”

2 Tim 3:16 - All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;

2 Pet 1:21 - for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.
